

# NCLOA / Whistle Stop 70-second Shot Clock Mechanics

## 3-man Mechanics

- The Single-Side official will take the 20-second clearing using their beeper.
- The Single-Side official will initiate the first 70-second shot clock by pressing the Whistle Stop (WS) timing device and signal by putting arm straight up and twirling arm/hand/fingers. Partners should all mirror the signal.
- When shot clock hits 60-seconds all officials will say, "UNDER" and point in the direction of attacking team.
- The Trail official will take all resets after valid shots, "Play-ons," timeouts and time-serving penalties by pressing the button on the WS timing device and using the "Reset" signal. As a backup ONLY, and IF the Trail official misses a "Reset," the other two officials could reset the shot clock.

## 2-man Mechanics

- The Trail official will take the 20-second clearing count using their beeper.
- The Trail official will initiate the first 70-second shot clock by pressing the Whistle Stop (WS) timing device and signal by putting arm straight up and twirling arm/hand/fingers. Partners should all mirror the signal.
- When shot clock hits 60-seconds all officials will say, "UNDER" and point in the direction of attacking team.
- The Trail official will take all resets after valid shots, "Play-ons," timeouts and time-serving penalties by pressing the button on the WS timing device and using the "Reset" signal. As a backup ONLY, and IF the Trail official misses a "Reset," the other official could reset the shot clock.
